On January 24, 2013, Governor Pat Quinn signed a new law extending sexual abuse education in Illinois schools. Erin's Law requires all schools to provide child sexual abuse prevention education for all students, early childhood through 12th grade, yearly. The law also allows parents to choose to not have their child participate in the presentation.
